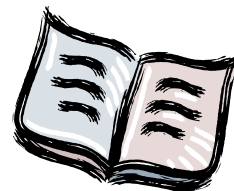

SMHA is encouraging all players to wear a mouth guard. It helps to protect teeth and is thought to reduce the risk of a concussion caused by falls and collisions.

Parents, you can speak to your child's dentist for their advice (a molded mouth guard is available from them). Also, inquire at your sports shop for information on the different brands they carry and why they are recommended.
