

The City of Surrey has provided us with the following guidelines.

- Masks are no longer mandatory in the facility as of the 19th, however they are recommended;
- We will be reverting back to our regular pre -COVID policy of 45 minutes to access your dressing room prior to your rental. We would ask that you access the dressing room as close to the start time as possible as this will reduce congestion and allow for additional cleaning.
- There is still a 20 minute requirement to exit the dressing room;
- Screening is entirely the responsibility of the individual that is entering the facility. There will be passive screening signs at the entrance provided by the City;
- There is no longer a requirement for groups to screen or take attendance;
- Entering and exiting will no longer be regulated, the doors will be unlocked;
- You can now lock your dressing room;
- The PHO still stipulates no more than 50% seating capacity for spectators and this is the responsibility of the group to manage. In order to keep accurate numbers of spectators, it is important that all spectators are out of the arena prior to the next group of spectators coming in. We ask that spectators are allowed into the arena just prior to the ice time and asked to leave immediately after the ice time. Groups may need to designate a person to oversee this;
- Instead of using the lobby for gearing up, we recommend using the dressing rooms so as to avoid lobby congestion. The lobbies have been designated an area of refuge for anyone needing to get out of the heat and/or smoke from the wildfires (if that occurs) until further notice.
